


Analysis of Alumni students on Curriculum 2023-24

1. The curriculum you studied, would be a right path in career point of view?





5. The curriculum develops skills, competency and spirit.




There were more than 90% students agree and strongly agree about curriculum helps to develop skills, competency and spirit among them.

2. The curriculum has enriched you with knowledge required for pursuing a good career.




There were more than 85% students agree and strongly agree about curriculum is enriched with knowledge. Very few students were disagreed and neutral.

4. The curriculum has prepared you to face future professional challenges.




There were about 85% students agree and strongly agree while 14% students disagree and neutral about curriculum which they study to solve future professional challenges.

6. The curriculum provides scope for development of creativity and boosts emotional/intellectual growth:




The scope for development of creativity and intellectual growth in curriculum were mentioned more than 80% students.

9. The curriculum addresses the needs of the individual as well as the society:




The curriculum addresses the needs of individual and society viewed by more than 85% while 15% students disagree.
