Activity-1: Celebration of Constitution Day

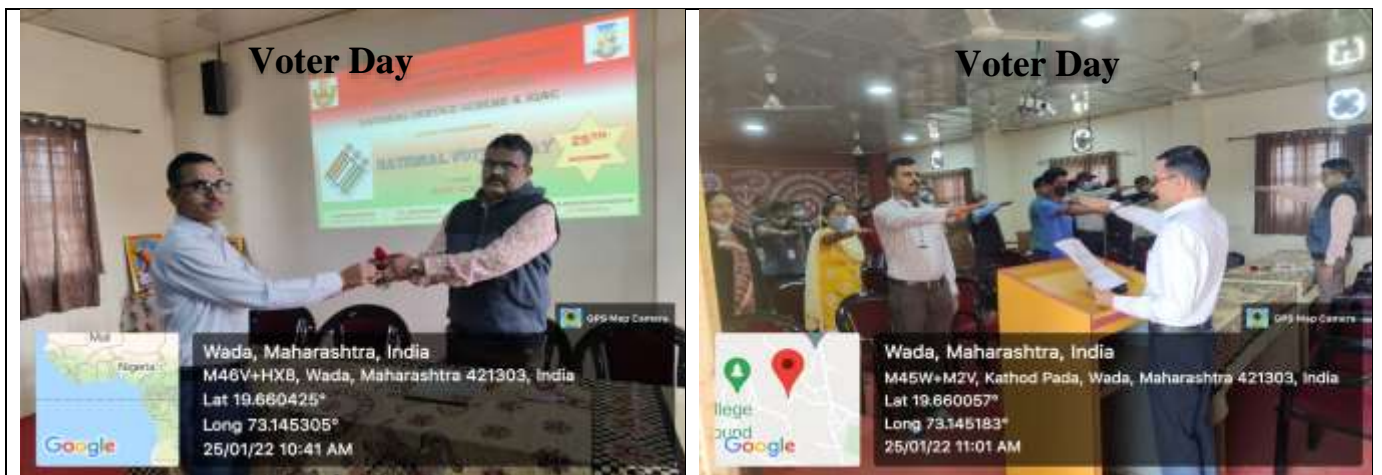
