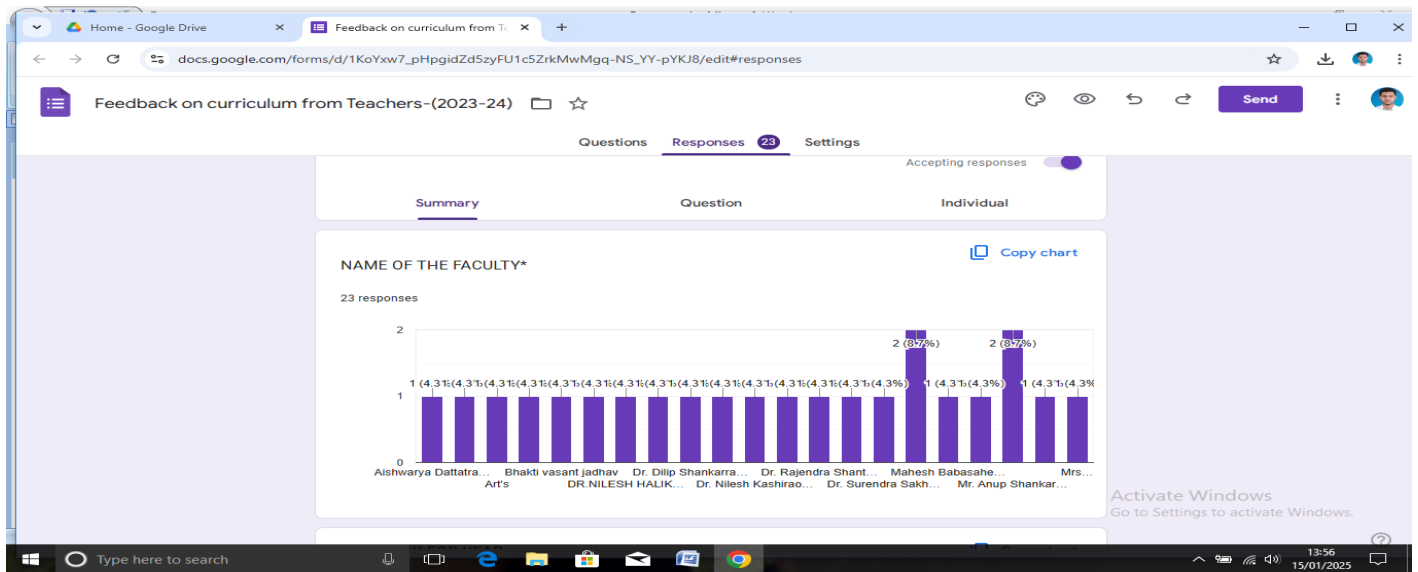

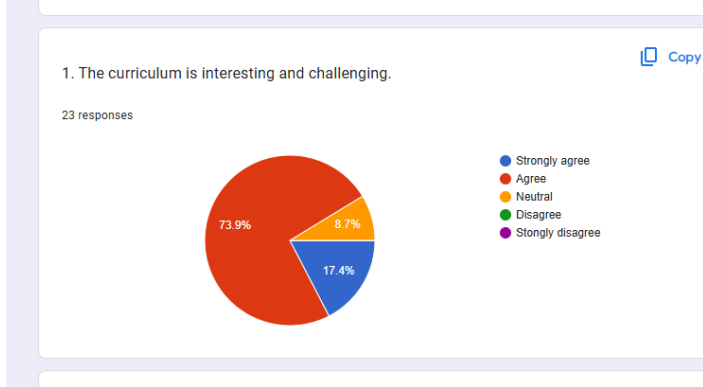

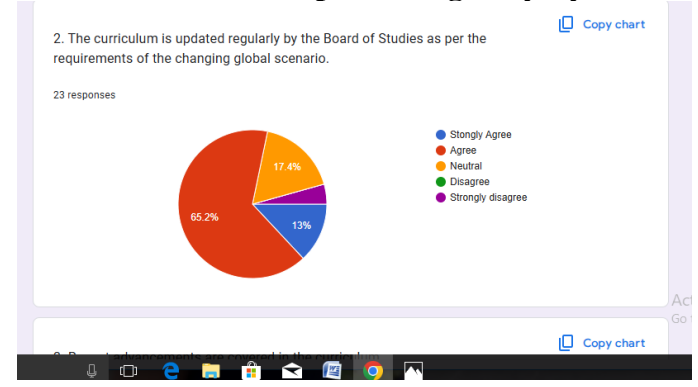
Feedback Analysis on Curriculum from Teachers 2023-24

1. Curriculum is interesting and challenging:



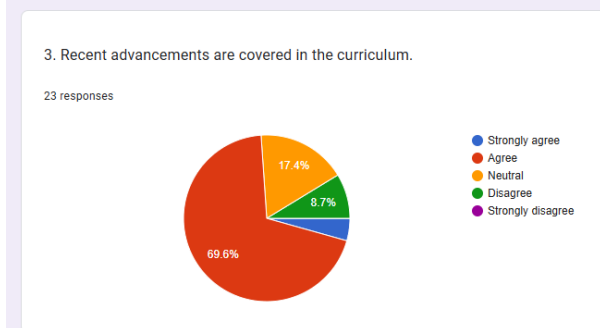
There were more than 80% faculty members agree and strongly agree with curriculum which is beneficial interesting, challenging to students for future purpose.

2. The curriculum is updated regularly by BOS:



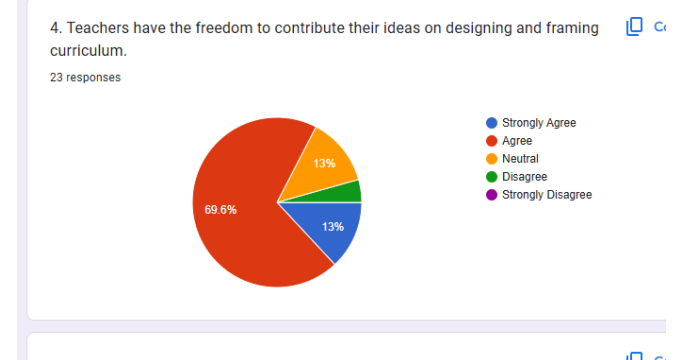
There were more than 80% faculty members agree and strongly agree with curriculum is updated regularly and changing global scenario.

3. Recent Advancements are covered in the curriculum:



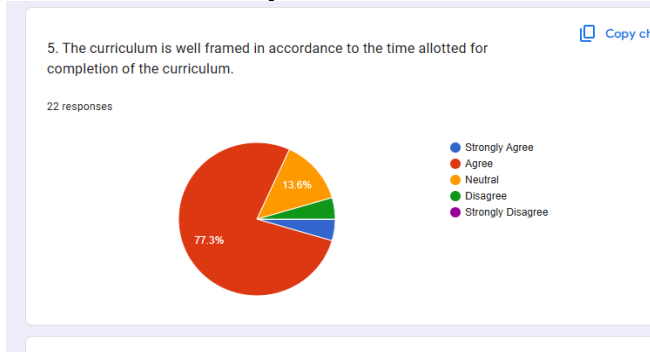
There were more than 70% faculty members agree and strongly agree with recent advancements are covered in the curriculum.

4. Teachers have the freedom to contribute their ideas on designing and framing curriculum:



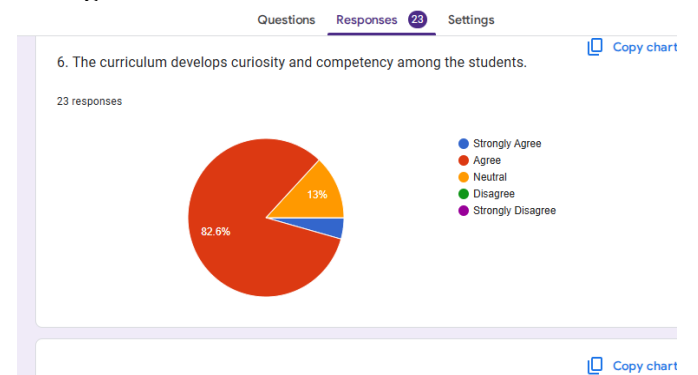
More than 70% faculty agree and strongly agree they have freedom to contribute their ideas on designing and framing curriculum.

5. The curriculum is well framed in accordance to the time allotted for completion of the curriculum:



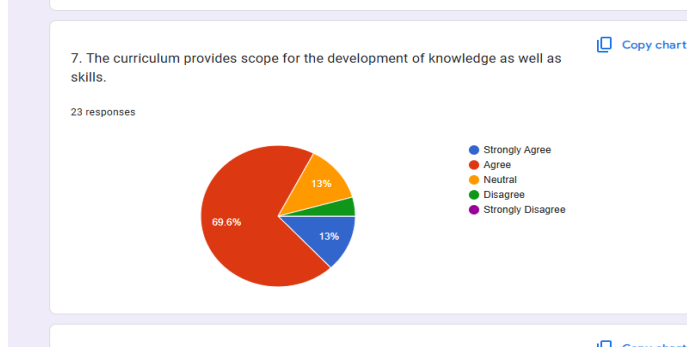
Almost everyone were agree and strongly agree about the frame of curriculum according to the time allotted for the same.

6. The curriculum develops curiosity and competency among the students:



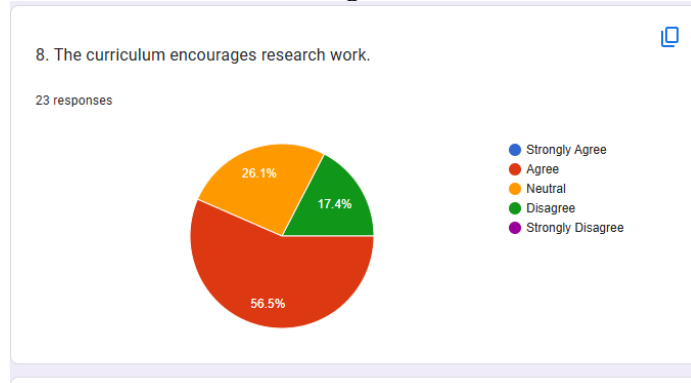
There were more than 80% faculty members agree and strongly agree with curriculum develops curiosity and competency among between students.

7. The curriculum provides scope for the development of knowledge as well as skills:



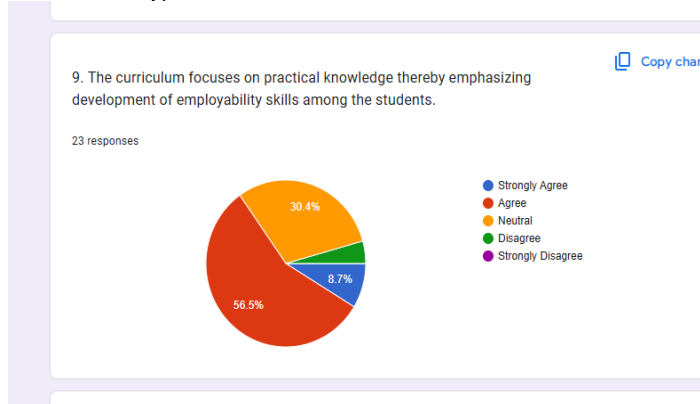
More than 80% faculty members agree and strongly agree with curriculum provides knowledge and skills.

8. The curriculum encourages research work:



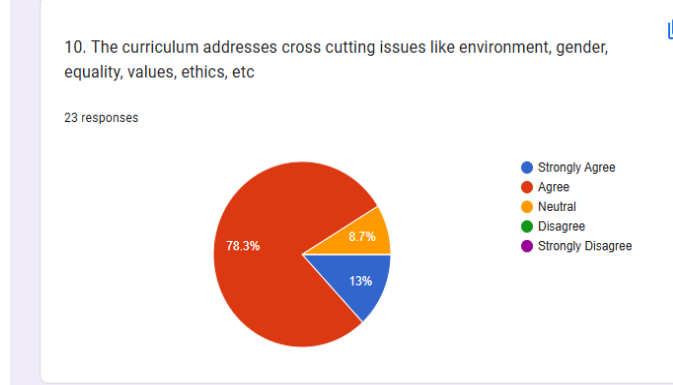
There were about 60% faculty members agrees about curriculum encourages research work.
