Response:

The institution is highly committed to minimizing waste and recycling through scientific methods such as dumping garbage in designated grounds. Waste is carefully segregated into solid and liquid categories. The institution has established a collaboration with the Nagar Panchayat for waste disposal.

Solid Waste Management: Separate dustbins are strategically placed for the collection of dry and wet waste. Students and staff are encouraged to utilize these bins effectively, with motivational instructions displayed on walls and bins. Garbage and waste are collected by a Nagar Panchayat-provided garbage van. NSS Volunteers actively participate in the "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan."

Liquid Waste Management: The institution has a drainage system in place for liquid waste disposal. Laboratory outlets are connected to this drainage system. Liquid waste from boys' and girls' toilets is directed to soak pits.

E-waste Management: E-waste is securely stored in the college storeroom. All teaching and non-teaching staff members are educated about the proper handling of computer-related devices.
